

Requirements or steps

- Focused on a what is measured in the process
- Identifying policy makers data needs
 - Priority setting for data or survey
- Refining HIS / Conducting surveys
- Analysing the data for health issues or problems
 - At national or regional level
- Identifying policy focus or refining and adjusting existing policies
 - Commonly a preferred source of evidence for national policy makers

Progress on the health-related Sustainable Development Goals and targets in the Eastern Mediterranean Region, 2023








