Research Director for Social Computing, Qatar Computing Research Institute (QCRI)

Dr Ingmar Weber is the Research Director for Social Computing at the Qatar Computing Research Institute (QCRI), HBKU. His interdisciplinary research uses large amounts of online data from social media and other sources to study human behavior at scale. Particular topics of interest include studying quantifying international migration using digital methods, tracking digital gender gaps, and mapping poverty. In his work Dr Weber regularly engages with UN agencies and NGOs, helping them to use non-traditional data sources to address their operational needs. Prior to joining QCRI, Dr Weber was a researcher at Yahoo Research Barcelona. As an undergraduate he studied mathematics at the university of Cambridge, before pursuing a PhD at the Max-Planck Institute for Computer Science. He's an ACM Distinguished Speaker and a IEEE and AAAI Senior Member.
