Salah AlMuzahmi, Ph.D. is the Director of Research & Development Indicators department at the Statistical Centre for the Cooperation Council for the Arab Countries of the Gulf (GCC-Stat) since March 2017. He is also the acting director of the Population and Social statistics.

Salah AlMuzahmi, Ph.D. was the Deputy Director General of Planning & Studies in the Ministry of Health, Sultanate of Oman. He joined the Oman MoH in 1992 as Regional health statistician in Dhahira District. In 2004, He appointed as the director of the Department of Health Information and Statistics in MoH Oman. He was also an active member in 12 national committees that are related to health and statistics such as Maternal Mortality committee, five-year health plan, Health insurance. He is also appointed as a national surveys coordinator for some of health related surveys such as GSHS, GYTS, etc.
